In addition, you may also upload copies of papers you have written, descriptions of projects you have taken part in, or other materials you think will strengthen your application in the "Supplemental Information" section.

All required materials (including transcripts, official GRE scores, recommendation letters, MU Graduate School Application) must be submitted no later than January 15, 2019 for full consideration. Applications received after January 15 will not be considered for assistantships. Final application deadline for Fall 2019 admittance is April 1, 2019.
